Pursuant to Regulation 30 read with Para B of Part A of Schedule III of the Listing Regulations and SEBI Circular thereon dated July 13, 2023, we hereby inform you that a writ petition has been filed by Greater Kailash Residents' Association & Ors, petitioners before the Hon'ble Delhi High Court praying for stay on construction of 400-bed multispeciality hospital in Greater Kailash – 1, New Delhi by GHL Hospital Limited, a Joint Venture of Global Health Limited and DLF Limited.

The captioned matter was listed before High Court today and notice has been issued to all Parties. Parties have been directed to file their replies before the next date of hearing (i.e. 12.09.2025). **With respect to Petitioners' prayer for a stay on the construction activities, no stay or any other interim relief was granted by the Hon'ble Court in the matter.**

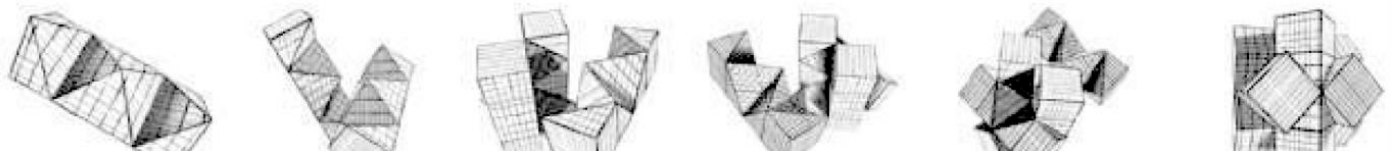

Brief details of litigation viz. name(s) of the opposing party, court/ tribunal/agency where litigation is filed, brief details of dispute/litigation	<p>A writ petition has been filed by Greater Kailash Residents' Association and certain residents of Greater Kailash-I against Union of India, Ministry of Environment & Forestry, Municipal Corporation of Delhi, Delhi Development Authority, Govt. of NCT of Delhi, DLF Limited, Lal Chand Public Charitable Trust, inter alia Global Health Limited (Company) and GHJ Hospital Limited (a subsidiary of Company) etc. before the High Court of Delhi, at Delhi. In the said writ, Petitioners have prayed for various reliefs inter alia, directions to MCD to restrain the DLF Limited, Lal Chand Public Charitable Trust, Global Health Limited and GHJ Hospital Limited from allowing/doing any construction on the plot sites. The captioned matter was listed before Delhi High Court today, i.e., on 11.07.2025, and notice has been issued to all Parties and the Parties have been directed to file their replies before the next date of hearing (i.e. 12.09.2025). The Petitioners requested the Hon'ble Court to grant a stay on the construction on the hospital plots in the interim. However, the Hon'ble Court did not find any merit in Petitioners' counsel's submissions and hence no stay on construction activities or any other interim relief has been granted by the Hon'ble Court in the matter.</p> <p>The Company and its subsidiary M/s GHJ Hospital Limited are parties to the above litigation. The petition seeks a writ of mandamus or other appropriate writ restraining the authorities from proceeding with the project due to alleged discrepancies in obtaining statutory clearances and concerns raised by the residents regarding its impact on the locality.</p>
2.	Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty etc.	At present, there are no direct financial implications such as compensation or penalties imposed.
3.	Quantum of claims, if any	No specific financial claim or compensation has been raised by the petitioners as of now. The reliefs sought are in the nature of injunctive directions restraining further action on the project.
